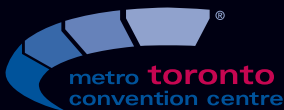

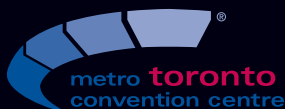

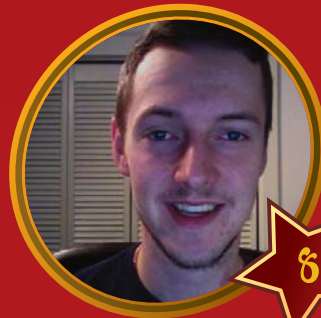

4. The auction guide is subject to additions or deletions that will be announced the evening of the dinner or posted at time of sale.
5. All auction items must be removed from the Metro Toronto Convention Centre at the end of the evening except where delivery has been offered. If delivery has been offered, please provide the cashiers with a filled out 'shipping form' with your delivery address and day-time contact information.
6. All items are tax exempt. No tax receipts are provided for items purchased.
